A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$7,000,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, by amending sections 1 and 9 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-26, 18-41 and 18-54, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
