A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by creating a new subchapter III on the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated 1 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by 2 creating a new subchapter III entitled: "Code of the FSM 3 (Annotated)". 4 Section 2. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated 5 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by 6 adding a new section 251 to subchapter III, to read as follows: 7 "Section 251. Code of the Federated States of Micronesia 8 9 (Annotated); Statement of Intent. This section is intended to effect a codification of the general and permanent 10 11 National laws of the Federated States of Micronesia and is not intended to effect any substantive changes therein." 12 Section 3. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated 13 14 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new section 252 to subchapter III of chapter 2, to read 15 as follows: 16

17"Section 252. Designation of code. The attached manuscript18is incorporated by reference herein and is hereby designated

1	as the "Code of the Federated States of Micronesia			
2	(Annotated)". This code contains the general and permanent			
3	National laws of the Federated States of Micronesia and is			
4	prepared under the authority of the Congress of the			
5	Federated States of Micronesia."			
6	Section 4. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated			
7	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by			
8	adding a new section 253 to subchapter III, to read as follows:			
9	"Section 253. Adoption as positive law.			
10	(1) All enacted law of the Congress of the Federated			
11	States of Micronesia as adopted and enacted in subchapter I			
12	of chapter 2 of title 1 of this code and all enacted general			
13	and permanent National laws of the Congress of the Federated			
14	States of Micronesia through the end of the 17 th Congress of			
15	the Federated States of Micronesia which are incorporated as			
16	part II of the attached manuscript are hereby readopted and			
17	reenacted as positive law of the Federated States of			
18	Micronesia in the form appearing in the manuscript.			
19	(2) The tables of contents, sources, cross-references,			
20	editor's notes, and errata are not to be construed as an			
21	adoption of those citations and resources, and these are			
22	included in the code as additional tools for research and			
23	are for reference purposes only.			
24	(3) All code sections that are designated as included			
25	for reference only are included in the code as additional			

1	tools for research and are not readopted and reenacted.			
2	(4) All enacted law which are readopted and reenacted			
3	pursuant to subsection (1) of this section are hereby			
4	repealed in its prior form."			
5	Section 5. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated			
6	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by			
7	adding a new section 254 to subchapter III, to read as follows:			
8	"Section 254. Other documents not adopted. The inclusion			
9	in parts I, III, and IV relating to the Constitution of the			
10	Federated States of Micronesia, the Government of the Trust			
11	Territory of the Pacific Islands, the state constitutions,			
12	the cross-reference table(s), and the index are not a part			
13	of the code and are not to be construed as an adoption of			
14	these documents and are included in the code for reference			
15	purposes only and to add additional resources and tools for			
16	research."			
17	Section 6. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated			
18	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by			
19	adding a new section 255 to subchapter III, to read as follows:			
20	"Section 255. Laws unaffected. Nothing in this Act affects			
21	the validity of either appropriation laws, other temporary			
22	National laws not included in this code, or laws enacted			
23	after the Seventeenth Congress of the Federated States of			
24	<u>Micronesia.</u> "			
25	Section 7. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated

1	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by			
2	adding a new section 256 to subchapter III, to read as follows:			
3	"Section 256. Rights and liabilities unaffected. The			
4	repeal in subsection (4) of section 253 of this subchapter			
5	does not affect the status of any civil or criminal actions,			
6	rights, or liabilities existing before the repeal takes			
7	<u>effect.</u> "			
8	Section 8. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated			
9	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by			
10	adding a new section 257 to subchapter III, to read as follows:			
11	"Section 257. Government authority unaffected. The			
12	republication in this code of Trust Territory laws and the			
13	retention of any references therein to the authority of the			
14	Government of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands are			
15	not intended to alter, diminish, or in any way change or			
16	affect the authority of the National Government or the			
17	respective State governments of the Federated States of			
18	Micronesia over the subject of legislation included therein,			
19	as that authority has been established by the Constitution			
20	of the Federated States of Micronesia, the State			
21	constitutions, and other applicable law."			
22	Section 9. Chapter 2 title 1 of the Code of the Federated			
23	States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by			
24	adding a new section 258 to subchapter III, to read as follows:			
25	"Section 258. State law reaffirmed. The authority of the

3	jurisdiction of the States is unaffected and hereby			
4	reaffirmed."			
5	Section 10. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the			
6	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further			
7	amended by adding a new section 259 to subchapter III, to read as			
8	follows:			
9	"Section 259. Technical amendments to the laws. Technical			
10	amendments to the laws included in part II of this code,			
11	whether or not those laws are readopted and reenacted			
12	pursuant to section 253 of this subchapter, are hereby			
13	enacted regarding the following:			
14	(1) organization, numbering, and references to titles			
15	chapters, subchapters, parts, sections, subsections, and			
16	<u>other subparts;</u>			
17	(2) changes in phraseology;			
18	(3) changes in introductory materials; and			
19	(4) correction of typographical, grammatical, or other			
20	errors."			
21	Section 11. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the			
22	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further			
23	amended by adding a new section 260 to subchapter III, to read as			
24	follows:			
25	"Section 260. Future amendments; citations.

1	(1) Future amendments to laws included in part II of			
2	this code, whether or not those laws are readopted and			
3	reenacted pursuant to section 253 of this subchapter, shall			
4	be made with reference to such laws as they appear in this			
5	<u>code.</u>			
6	(2) The preferred citation of laws included in part I			
7	of this code is as follows: first, the title number in			
8	Arabic numerals; second, `F.S.M.C.'; and third, section			
9	number. Example: The citation of section 201,			
10	<u>'Qualifications of Senators,' of title 9, 'National</u>			
11	Elections,' would appear as `9 F.S.M.C. 201'."			
12	Section 12. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the			
13	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further			
14	amended by adding a new section 261 to subchapter III, to read as			
15	follows:			
16	"Section 261. Supplements as part of code.			
17	(1) The laws contained in any current pocket parts or			
18	supplements to this code, printed and published under			
19	contract or otherwise as may be authorized by law,			
20	constitute prima facie a part of this code if the laws, as			
21	so contained, purport to represent reproductions of			
22	statutory amendments to this code, as stated in accompanying			
23	notes thereto.			
24	(2) If pocket parts or supplements are published on a			
25	cumulative basis, then only the laws in the latest			

publication thereof constitute prima facie a part of this 1 2 code. 3 (3) If any discrepancy arises between the text of a provision set out in the current supplement and that 4 5 contained in the basic Act as separately printed and published by the President of the Federated States of 6 7 Micronesia or his designee pursuant to the authority granted by law, the latter shall constitute the positive law and 8 9 shall control." Section 13. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the 10 11 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further 12 amended by adding a new section 262 to subchapter III, to read as 13 follows: "Section 262. Repealer. The Trust Territory Code to the 14 15 extent it is not republished herein or reaffirmed as within the jurisdiction of the States by sections 257 and 258 of 16 this subchapter are hereby repealed in its entirety." 17 Section 14. Chapter 2 title 1 of the Code of the Federated 18 States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by 19 adding a new section 263 to subchapter III, to read as follows: 20 21 "Section 263. Authorization for publication of F.S.M.C.. 22 The publishing of the official edition of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia 2014 edition (Annotated) 23 (F.S.M.C.), pursuant to contract with the Congress of the 24 25 Federated States of Micronesia is hereby authorized."

1	Section 15. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the			
2	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further			
3	amended by adding a new section 264 to subchapter III, to read as			
4	follows:			
5	"Section 264. Contents of F.S.M.C The Code of the			
6	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated) shall contain the			
7	general and permanent National laws codified as positive law			
8	in the F.S.M.C. pursuant to sections 251 through 265 of this			
9	subchapter III of this chapter, supplemented and updated			
10	with any amendments or additions to the law requiring			
11	codification through the end of the Seventeenth Congress of			
12	the Federated States of Micronesia."			
13	Section 16. Chapter 2 of title 1 of the Code of the			
14	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further			
15	amended by adding a new section 265 to subchapter III, to read as			
16	follows:			
17	"Section 265. Laws unaffected by earlier publication. The			
18	supplementing and updating to the original 1982 F.S.M.C. in			
19	the First Supplement authorized by Public Law No. 4-33, any			
20	subsequent codifications, and in this codification with			
21	subsequently enacted general and permanent National laws,			
22	shall not effect any substantive change to the law as			
23	enacted and as it became effective."			
24	Section 17. This act shall become law upon approval by the			
25	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its			

1	becoming law without	such approval.
