A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 18-70 by amending sections 3, 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs in the States of Kosrae and Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
