## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 809 of title 53 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-37, 14-86, 15-73 and 16-10, to modify the payment of benefits to foreign citizens outside the Federated States of Micronesia, to give an additional option of fully vesting in the Social Security Administration program for retirement benefits after 100 quarters (25 years), and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 809 of title 53 of the Code of the

2 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos.

3 14-37, 14-86, 15-73 and 16-10, is hereby further amended to read 4 as follows:

5 "Section 809. <u>Payment of benefits to foreign citizens</u>
6 outside Federated States of Micronesia.

7 Unless modified by a totalization or other international 8 agreement, benefit payments under this act shall be paid 9 to a beneficiary who is not a citizen or a national of 10 the Federated States of Micronesia and does not reside 11 in the Federated States of Micronesia, as follows:

(a) Payments shall be made to citizens and nationals
of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall
Islands, and the United States as if they were citizens
or nationals of the Federated States of Micronesia as
long as the Social Security Administration of those
nations gives citizens and nationals of the Federated

1 States of Micronesia reciprocal treatment. 2 (b) For applications filed after this bill becomes 3 law, payments shall be made to citizens and nationals of other nations, at their option of 4 1) if they [are fully insured] have contributed 5 100 quarters (25 years) consecutively to the Social 6 7 Security Administration at the time of application, to be treated for purposes of benefits under this title the 8 same as a FSM citizen that is fully insured. [in a lump 9 sum equal to the total amount contributed to the Social 10 11 Security Administration by the employee under section 12 901 of the act while employed in the Federated States of Micronesia as of the date the employee turns age 60 or 13 14 is no longer employed in the Federated States of 15 Micronesia, whichever is later, or dies prior to age 60. All payments due under this section shall be payable 16 over six [months] years, from the date of death, or the 17 date of turning age 60, and/or the date of filing an 18 application for such benefits, whichever is later 19 20 [subject to the residency provision in paragraph (d)] less any monthly or periodic payments received; or 21 22 2) if they have contributed 50 quarters (12.5 23 years) consecutively to the Social Security Administration at the time of application, in a lump sum 24 25 equal to the total amount contributed to the Social

Security Administration by the employee under section 1 2 901 of the act while employed in the Federated States of 3 Micronesia as of the date the employee turns age 60 or is no longer employed in the Federated States of 4 5 Micronesia, whichever is later, or dies prior to age 60. All payments due under this section shall be payable 6 7 over six months, from the date of death, or the date of turning age 60, and/or the date of filing an application 8 for such benefits, whichever is later subject to the 9 residency provision in paragraph (d) less any monthly or 10 11 periodic payments received. (c) For applications filed prior to the date of this 12 13 bill becomes law, payments shall be made to citizens and nationals of other nations if they have contributed 50 14 <u>quarters (12.5 years) to the</u> Social Security 15 Administration in a lump sum equal to the total amount 16 contributed to the Social Security Administration by the 17 employee under section 901 while employed in the 18 Federated States of Micronesia as of the date the 19 20 employee ceases to be a resident of the Federated States 21 of Micronesia in accordance with paragraph (d) of this 22 section, turns age 60 or is no longer employed in the Federated States of Micronesia, whichever is later, or 23 dies prior to age 60. All payments due under this 24 25 section shall be payable over six months, from the date

of death, or the date of turning age 60, and/or the date
 of filing an application fro such benefits, whichever is
 later subject to the residency provision in paragraph
 (d) less any monthly or periodic payments received.

5 (d) For <u>the purposes</u> of this section, an individual 6 resides in the Federated States of Micronesia if they 7 are present in the territory of the Federated States of 8 Micronesia for 180 days out of the last 365 days and 9 have ties to the Federated States of Micronesia that 10 indicate residence such as a home, vehicle, bank account 11 or personal property.

In determining the benefits and entitlements under 12 (e) 13 this title for an individual who receives a lump sum 14 payment in accordance with paragraphs (b), (c) or (d) of 15 this section and who subsequently returns to the Federated States of Micronesia to undertake further 16 covered employment, no covered quarters, employee 17 contributions or employer contributions accrued by the 18 individual prior to receiving a lump sum payment shall 19 20 be counted."
