A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03, 16-11, 16-33, 16-46, 17-12, 17-21, 17-33, 17-40, 18-17 and 18-67, by amending section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the State of Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended

8	year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose of			
9	funding public projects and social programs in each			
10	State of the Federated States of Micronesia. The			
11	fund shall be apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or			
12	less per member of Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT			
13	an increase of \$300,000 is for Yap State.
