## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Public Law No. 18-05 for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

21	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
22	managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
23	applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
24	Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
25	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under 3 section [2] 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections  $[\frac{3}{2}]$  and 4 5 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of section 5 of this act 10 11 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. 12 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section 13 5 of this act [shall be the Faichuk Development Authority] 14 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of section 15 16 5 of this act [shall be the Southern Namoneas Development 17 Authority] shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(6) of section 18 5 of this act shall be the Northwest Island Development 19 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds 20 21 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2014. 22 23 24
