## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-84, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-96, 14-103, 14-08, 15-13, 15-37, 15-42, 15-53, 16-8, 16-44, 17-17 and 17-61, by amending section 9 thereof, to change the allottee and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 14-84, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-96, 15-13, 15-53, 16-8, 16-44, 17-17 and 17-61, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 9. All funds appropriated by this act shall 4 5 be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not 6 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 7 The allottee of the funds appropriated in Section 1 8 of this Act shall be the President of the Federated 9 States of Micronesia or the President's designee, 10 11 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated in subsection (1) (f) of Section 1 of this Act shall be 12 the Governor of the State of Kosrae. The allottee of 13 the funds appropriated in Sections 2 and 3 of this 14 Act shall be the [Chuuk State Commission on 15 16 Improvement Project] Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated in 17 Section 4 of this Act shall be the Governor of Yap 18 State. The allottee shall be responsible for 19

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| 2  | be necessary, are used solely for the purpose               |
| 3  | specified in this act, and that no obligations are          |
| 4  | incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The             |
| 5  | authority of the allottee to obligate funds                 |

| 8  | Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the   |
| 9  | President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its |
| 10 | becoming law without such approval.                         |
