Dear Speaker Halbert:

The following Congressional Act became **Public Law No. 18-41** pursuant to Section 22 Article IX of the FSM Constitution:

Congressional Act No. 18-51: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET OF \$9,530,869 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 8 AND 9 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-15, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-26, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

I take this opportunity to thank Congress for passing the supplemental budget during the third regular session. The amount recommended for supplemental funding was \$12.4. This act approves \$9.5 million to the exclusion of essential and urgent line items, some of them are as follows:

- Set aside – \$5.0 million;
- Data Validation & Analysis - \$126,402;
- Assistance to States on NCD - \$125,698;
- President's Prayer Day;
- President's Visits to outer island;
- South Pacific Tourism Org Membership fee - \$27,000;
- Tourism Development Framework - \$250,000;
- Compact Review Committee - \$95,000;
- ODA Policy - \$71,250;
- Development Partners Meeting - \$72,664.

I urge Congress to reconsider the supplemental budget in light of the national capacity to establish a set aside fund and in view of a certainty of fiscal deficit in the near future. We must prepare ourselves and we must not delay any further.

I will resubmit the supplemental budget for consideration at the earliest opportunity.

AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$9,530,869 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by Public Law No. 18-26, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 18-26, is hereby further amended to read as  
3 follows:

16 funds available under the Amended Compact from the  
17 health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds  
18 available under the Amended Compact from the

1 infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come  
2 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the  
3 public sector capacity building; \$-0- shall be deemed  
4 to come from funds available under the Amended Compact  
5 from the enhanced reporting and accountability sector;  
6 and \$1,112,158 shall be deemed to come from funds  
7 available under the Supplemental Education Grant. The

be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the education sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from public capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and \$799,666 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant. 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
