Dear Speak Halbert:

I transmit the following Congressional Act, which became Public Law No. 18-99, due to Congressional override:

Congressional Act No. 18-96, entitled: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUME OF \$2,800,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING IN SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAM FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE STATES OF KOSRAE, CHUUK, POHNPEI AND YAP, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Although on November 19, 2014, Congress overrode my veto, through SCR 18-244, Congress misconstrued my veto message. I support well thought out and planned for public projects. This is why I increased the funding for public projects in the proposed FY2015 Annual Budget. Placing these funds in the Annual Budget provides transparency in the spending of public funds over a defined period of time. However, continually placing these designated funds in standalone appropriations such as what occurred in this case, erodes the Government's credibility to be responsible stewards of public money. This current appropriation process precludes effective tracking and validation of the use of these funds.

Moreover, holding public hearings on the use of public funds increases good governance through transparency.

22	All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, manage	ed,
23	administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable	e laws,
24	including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act	of
25	1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that	these

- 1 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
- 2 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
- 3 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
- 4 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
- 5 Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
- 6 appropriated under section 3 shall be the President or his
- 7 designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
- 8 section 3(a),(b),(c),(d), (e), (f), (g),(h), (i), (j)(k), (l),
- 9 (m), (n) and (o) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government. The
- 10 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall

5	Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds
6	appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the
7	Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated
8	under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be the General Manager of
9	the Northwest Island Development Authority. The authority of the
10	allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
11	September 30, 2015.
12	Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
14	becoming law without such approval.
