AN ACT

To amend sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Public Law No. 18-05 for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

BE I	T ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
2	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
3	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
4	ending September 30, 2013, for the purpose of funding public

10	Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
11	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
12	managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
13	applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
14	Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
15	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
16	necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
17	act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
19	section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State. The
20	allottee of funds appropriated under sections 2 and 4 of this
21	act shall be the President of the Federated States of
22	Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
23	under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act shall be the
24	Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds
25	appropriated under subsection 5(2) of section 5 of this act

1	shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
2	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section
3	5 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
4	Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
5	5(5) of section 5 of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
6	Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
7	5(6) of section 5 of this act shall be the Northwest Island
8	Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
9	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
10	September 30, 2014.
11	Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
12	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
13	becoming law without such approval.
