PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-110

AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$5,562,111 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, by amending sections 1, 2, 3 and 9, of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Law No. 18-102, to change the use of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by 2 Public Law No. 18-102, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to appropriate the sum of \$96,498,776 from the General Fund 4 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year 5 6 ending September 30, 2015, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National Government of 7 the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital 10 and Human Resources Development. The National 11 Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero except that the National Government will 12 retain ten percent (10%) of the Supplemental Education 13 14 Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for the Department of Education. 15 16 The budget shall also include appropriations for COM-FSM from sector grants as well as appropriations from amended 17 18 Compact carry-over funds.

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Public Law No. 18-102, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive 4 5 Branch. The sum of \$18,119,389, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from 6 the General Fund of the Federated States of 7 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 8 2015, for the purpose of funding the operations of 9 the Executive Branch of the National Government 10 11 during the fiscal year 2015.
