## EIGHTEENTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

## AN ACT

To appropriate \$45,166,002 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 11 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the health
- 12 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under
- 13 the Amended Compact from the infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be
- 14 deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact
- 15 from the public sector capacity building; \$-0- shall be deemed to
- 16 come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the
- 17 enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and \$1,112,158
- 18 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
