AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$1,889,072 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, by amending sections 1, 3, and 8 of Public Law No. 18-15, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-15 is hereby

2 amended to read as follows:

Title. The title of this act is as 3 "Section 1. follows: To appropriate the sum of \$47,055,074 from the 4 5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for 6 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the 7 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of 8 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, 9 10 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human 11 Resources Development. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$2,400,000 shall be deemed to come 12 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the 13 education sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from 14 funds available under the Amended Compact from the 15 16 health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the 17 18 infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the 19

1	public sector capacity building; \$-0- shall be deemed
2	to come from funds available under the Amended Compact
3	from the enhanced reporting and accountability sector;
4	and \$1,112,158 shall be deemed to come from funds
5	available under the Supplemental Education Grant. The
6	sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as
7	follows:"
8	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 18-15 is hereby
9	amended to read as follows:

11	Branch. The sum of \$3,505,228 or so much thereof as
12	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
13	General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for

16	Government during fiscal year 2014. The sum
