AN ACT

To appropriate \$55,098,704 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Title. The title of this act is as follows: 1 Section 1. То 2 appropriate the sum of \$\$55,098,704 from the General Fund of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 4 September 30, 2015, for the purpose of funding the operations of 5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of 6 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 7 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. The 8 National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been 9 reduced to zero except that the federal government will retain 10 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected 11 in the budget for the Department of Education. 16 Section 13. <u>Allotment and management of funds and lapse</u> 17 <u>dates</u>.

(1) General provisions.

(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance
with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
Management Act of 1979.

(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that
