## A RESOLUTION

To amend section 1(b) of Rule 11 of the Official Rules of Procedure for the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to provide that all witnesses testifying before Congressional Committees shall be administered an oath.

- 10 receive the truth from testifying witnesses, and also the law
- 11 that testifying witnesses should not give false statements; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is the belief of Congress that recently it
- 13 has been gravely misled by witnesses testifying at
- 14 Congressional Committee Hearings; now, therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED ON BEHALF OF THE PEOPLE by the Eighteenth
- 16 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular
- 17 Session, 2014, that section 1(b) of Rule 11 of the Official
- 18 Rules of Procedure for the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated
- 19 States of Micronesia be amended as follows:
- "(b) The Speaker, committee chairmen, [and]other
