## A RESOLUTION

Urging the President to reduce maritime operations by two patrol boats. 1 WHEREAS, the budget of this nation will continue to face 2 pressures from the decrement in Compact funding; and WHEREAS, this nation spends over \$1,500,000 per year on 3 patrol boats; and 4 WHEREAS, these costs each and every year include \$750,000 for 5 6 slipping, \$500,000 for fuel subsidies, \$125,000 for patrol boat maintenance, and over \$125,000 on salaries for maritime 7 surveillance officers; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the current number of patrol boats operating are sometimes dangerously under-manned; now, therefore 10 11 BE IT RESOLVED that the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, Fifth Regular Session, 2014, hereby urges 12 the President to retire two patrol boats from operation as soon as 13 14 practically possible; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 15 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States 16 17 of Micronesia. 18 19 Date: 9/15/14 Introduced by: <u>/s/ Peter M.
