To ratify the Treaty Between the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and the Government of the United States of America on the Delimitation of a Maritime Boundary.

- 2 of the Federated States of Micronesia is set forth in Article I of
- 3 the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia and
- 4 elaborated upon in title 18 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 5 Micronesia, including assertion of an exclusive economic zone
- 6 extending up to 200 nautical miles outward from baselines; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Federated States of
- 8 Micronesia permits limitation of jurisdiction over waters pursuant
- 9 to international treaty obligations; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the maritime jurisdiction between Federated States
- 11 of Micronesia and the United States of America (Guam) overlap in
- 12 some areas; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the international practice in this circumstance is
- 14 for the parties to negotiate a maritime boundary delimitation
- 15 treaty, which the Federated States of Micronesia and the United
- 16 States of America have done so; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the negotiated treaty between the Federated States
- 18 of Micronesia and the United States of America establishes a line
- 19 of delimitation between their respective maritime jurisdiction on
- 20 the basis of equidistance; and
