

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant assistance in the amount of \$949,600 from the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), for the implementation of UNFPA-funded Annual Work Plans relating to the 2013-2017 UNFPA Multi-Country Programme for the Pacific Island Countries and Territories, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, on April 8, 2013, the United Nations Population
2 Fund (UNFPA) extended to the Government of the Federated States
3 of Micronesia a grant assistance (the 'Grant') in the amount
4 of \$949,600, as evidence by the Annual Work Plan (AWP) of the
5 same date; and

6 WHEREAS, the grant assistance was awarded to the Federated
7 States of Micronesia for the specific purpose of funding the
8 implementation of UNFPA-funded AWP's relating to the 2013-2017
9 UNFPA Multi-Country Programme for the Pacific Island Countries
10 and Territories under the Department of Health and Social
11 Affairs of the Government of the Federated States of
12 Micronesia; and

13 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the
14 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia provides that for an
15 agreement on foreign financial assistance to be valid it must
16 be approved by Congress by resolution; and

1 WHEREAS, the FSM Government expresses appreciation to the
2 United Nations Population Fund for the grant programs made
3 available to the Federated States of Micronesia; now,
4 therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated
6 States of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 2013, that
7 Congress hereby approves and accepts the \$949,600 in grant
8 assistance from the United Nations Population Fund for the
9 implementation of UNFPA-funded AWP's relating to the 2013-2017
10 UNFPA Multi-Country Programme for the Pacific Island Countries
11 and Territories, including all the terms and conditions
12 thereof; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
14 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
15 States of Micronesia and the United Nations Population Fund.
