A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget in the amount of \$2,525,465 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, by amending sections 1, 2, and 9 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, and 18-116, and for other purposes.

BEI IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended
by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, and 18-116, is hereby
further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to 5 6 appropriate the sum of [\$96,498,776] \$99,024,241 from the 7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, for the purpose of 8 9 funding the operations of all branches of the National 10 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 11 12 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. The National Government's share of the Amended Compact 13 14 funds has been reduced to zero except that the National 15 Government will retain ten percent (10%) of the 16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in the 17 budget for the Department of Education. The budget shall also include appropriations for COM-FSM from sector grants 18 19 as well as appropriations from amended Compact carry-over

1 funds."

2 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, and 18-116, is hereby further 3 amended to read as follows: 4 5 "Section 2.
