A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$150,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, for the purpose of humanitarian relief efforts for victims of Typhoon Dolphin in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and the victims of the earthquakes in the Federal Democratic Republic Nepal, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. The sum of \$150,000 is hereby appropriated from
- 2 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
- 3 fiscal year ending September 30, 2015. The funds appropriated
- 4 under this section shall be used to fund humanitarian relief
- 5 efforts for victims of Typhoon Dolphin in the Commonwealth of the
- 6 Northern Mariana Islands and the victims of the earthquakes in the
- 7 Federal Democratic Republic Nepal. The funds appropriated under
- 8 this section shall be appropriated as follows:
- 9 (a) Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands .\$ 50,000
- 10 (b) Federal Democratic Republic Nepal 100,000
- 11 Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
- 12 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
- 13 administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
- 14 including but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
- 15 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated under this act shall
- 16 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
- 17 allottee of the funds appropriated herein shall be responsible for

ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
   are used solely for the purpose specified herein, and shall report
   back to Congress on the status of these funds no later than
   September 30, 2016. The authority of the allottee to obligate
   such funds shall lapse on September 30, 2016.
