## NINETEENTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws No. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135 and 19-146, in order to clarify the use of funds for a particular line item and to change the allottee for that line item, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135 and 19-146, is hereby
further amended to read as follows:

"Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. 4 5 The sum of \$31,329,363, which includes \$556,074 in SEG funding that was previously omitted, or so much 6 7 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of 8 9 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the following capital improvements, 10 development programs, and projects and human resources 11 12 development. Of the total amount of funds 13 appropriated herein, \$1,802,096 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact 14 15 from the Supplemental Education Grant and \$9,545,500 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 16 17 Amended Compact from Compact Sector Grants. Section 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125 and 19-135, is hereby further amended 6 to read as follows: 7 "Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds 8 9 and Lapse Dates. 10 (1) General provisions. (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be 11 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 12 13 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 14 15 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may 16 17 be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are 18 incurred in excess of the sums appropriated. 19 20 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds 21 appropriated by this act are as follows: (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds 2.2 shall be the President of the Federated States of 23 Micronesia; 24 25 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds

1 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated 2 States of Micronesia; (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds 3 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the 4 5 Federated States of Micronesia; (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds 6 7 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of 8 Micronesia: 9 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the 10 Federated States of Micronesia; PROVIDED, 11 HOWEVER, that for the following subsections of 12 13 sections 8 through 9 of this act: (i) Section 8(1)(g)(ii) - the 14 15 allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on Compact Review and 16 17 Planning (JCRP); (ii) Section 8(6)(g) - the allottee 18 shall be the President of the College of 19 20 Micronesia - FSM; 21 (iii) Section 8(6)(h) through (i) allottee of thse funds shall be the Governor of 2.2 Chuuk State. 23 24 (iv) Section 8 (9)(a) through (v) -25 the allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker

1 of the Congress of the Federated States of 2 Micronesia; (v) Section 8(12)(a) through (d) -3 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief 4 5 Justice of the respective State Supreme Court; (vi) Section 8(12)(o) - the allottee 6 7 of these funds shall be the Governor of the 8 respective States; 9 (vii) Section 8(12)(p) - the allottee 10 of these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap; 11 (viii) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) -12 13 the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM; 14 15 (ix) Section 9(3)(i)(i) - theallottee of these funds shall be the Governor of 16 17 the State of Yap; [(ix)](x) Section 9(4)(b) through (e) -18 the allottee of these funds shall be the 19 20 Governor of the respective States; 21  $\left[\frac{x}{2}\right](xi)$  Section 9(12)(b) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the 2.2 Chuuk State Supreme Court. 23 [(xi)](xii) Section 9(12)(d) - the allottee 24 25 of these funds shall be the Speaker of the

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1	Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.
2	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the
3	allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this
4	act shall lapse as of September 30, 2017,
5	PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated
6	under section 9 of this act shall not lapse."
7	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9	becoming law without such approval.
