AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Law No. 19-125, in order to appropriate \$877,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, to clarify certain line items and to modify their language to change their intended use, to divide one particular line item into two separate line items, to change the allottees for three line items, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
by Public Law No. 19-125, is hereby further amended to read as
