



AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-05, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-07, 18-14, 18-31, 18-38, 18-72, 18-82, 18-93, 18-105, 19-03 and 19-20, by amending sections 2, 4 and 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, for public projects and social programs in the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
