Dear Speaker Simina:

I am pleased to transmit the following Congressional Act, which I have approved to become Public Law No. 19-45:

Congressional Act No. 19-47, entitled: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$112,500 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 8, AND 12 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-32, TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL CONTRIBUTION TO THE INTER-PARLIAMENTARY UNION, TO PAY OVERDUE MEMBERSHIP FEES, TO DESIGNATE THE ALLOTTEE AND CHANGE THE ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

As indicated on its title, the Act appropriates \$112,500 as contribution to the Inter-Parliamentary Union including the payment of overdue membership fees. I find no issue with this supplemental budget; therefore, I signed into law.

However, the Act also deletes the lapse date of funds – subsection 12(3) in the budget. This could be a typographical error, but I urge Congress to reinstate this subsection at the earliest opportunity in order to avoid any doubt on the lapse date of funds in the FY16 Budget.

#### PUBLIC LAW No. 1 9- 45

#### AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget in the amount of \$112,500 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, by amending sections 1, 8, and 12 of Public Law No. 19-32, to provide for an additional contribution to the Inter-Parliamentary Union, to pay overdue membership fees, to designate the allottee and change the allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-32, is hereby 1 amended to read as follows: 2 The purpose of this act is as "Section 1. 3 Purpose. follows: To appropriate the sum of \$75,542,323 from the General Fund of the Federated States of 5 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various 9 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and 10 Capital and Human Resources Development. 11 National Government's share of the Amended Compact 12 funds has been reduced to zero except that the 13 National Government will retain 10 percent of the 14 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in 15 the budget for the Department of Education. The sum 16 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:" 17

1	Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 19-32 is hereby
