
I am pleased to transmit the following Congressional Act, which became Public Law No. 19-54, as follows:

Congressional Act No. 19-58, entitled: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$4,800,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATES OF YAP, KOSRAE, POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I signed this act into law because it is Congress' prerogative to appropriate public funds for public purpose. But the appropriation by Congress must be supported by actual revenue in order to validate the appropriation. In light of the uncertainty of actual revenue this year—including fishing fees—which I am sure you are aware, I recommend caution in further appropriating project funds before the fiscal year is ending in order for us to collectively maintain a balanced budget.

Moreover, I recommend that you rectify the allottee of funds for Kosrae. As it stands, the Lelu Town Mayor is the designated allottee of all Kosrae public projects and social programs, including subsidies to the municipalities, the Kosrae Legislature and the Attorney General's Office. This could be a drafting oversight; nonetheless, it needs to be corrected.

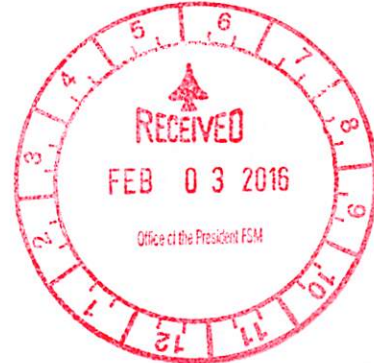





PUBLIC LAW No. 19-54

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$4,800,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The sum of \$4,800,000, or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
3 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
4 year ending September 30, 2016, for the purpose funding public
5 projects and social programs in the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei
6 and Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this section shall be
7 apportioned as follows:

8 Section 2. Of the sum of \$4,800,000 appropriated by this
9 act, \$700,000 is apportioned for public projects and social
10 programs in the state of Yap.

10 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
11 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
12 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
13 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
14 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
15 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
16 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
17 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
19 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State. The
20 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this
21 act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
22 or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
23 appropriated under subsections 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f),
24 (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p), (q), (r), (s),
25 (t), (u) and (v) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or

1 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsection 4(1) shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State or his
3 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
4 4(2) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
5 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee
6 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3) (b) and (d) shall
7 be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA). The allottee of
8 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3), 5(4)(e) and
9 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
10 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
11 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development
12 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
13 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
14 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
15 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
16 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by
17 this act shall lapse on September 30, 2017."

1 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.

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
