Congressional Act No. 19-85: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 40 OF THE CODE OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA (ANNOTATED), AS AUTHORIZED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-86, BY CREATING A NEW SUB-CHAPTER VIII UNDER CHAPTER 3, TO ESTABLISH A NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP BOARD, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

I wish to express appreciation for the efforts of the 19th Congress in passing the act. PUBLIC LAW No. 1 9- 90

AN ACT

To amend title 40 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as authorized by Public Law No. 18-86, by creating a new sub-chapter VIII under chapter 3, to establish a national scholarship board, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 108 of title 40 of the Code of the

Board. Regular meetings shall be held not less than
four times per calendar year, at such times and places
as shall be determined by the Scholarship Board."

hereby amended by adding a new section 394 under subchapter VIII
of chapter 3, to read as follows:
"Section 394. Quorum of the Scholarship Board. A
quorum of all regular business of the Scholarship Board
shall be three members."
Section 7. Title 40 of the Code of the Federated States of
Micronesia (Annotated), as authorized by Public Law No. 18-96, is
hereby amended by adding a new section 395 under subchapter VIII
of chapter 3, to read as follows:
"Section 395. Record of meetings of the Scholarship
Board. Full and accurate minutes of all meetings shall
be kept, including any documents and evaluations that
form the basis of awards of the post-secondary
