subsections 3(i), 3(j) and 3(k) shall be the Mayor of
Tafunsak Municipal Government; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a) shall be the
Mayor of Kolonia Town Government or his designee; the
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c)
shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of
Education or her designee; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsections 4(2)(b), 4(2)(d),
4(2)(e), $4(2)(f)$ , $4(4)(a)$ , $4(4)(b)$ , $4(4)(c)$ , $4(4)(d)$ and
4(4)(e) shall be the Secretary of the Department of
Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 4(3)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under

subsection 4(4)(f) shall be the Pohnpei Utility
Corporation. The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsections $5(1)$ , $5(3)$ , $5(4)(e)$ and $5(6)$ of this act

PROVIDED THAT; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 5(3)(d) of this act shall be Secretary of the
Department of Finance and Administration or her
designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
2018.
