

PUBLIC LAW No. 19-98

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84, 17-89, 17-90, 18-03, 18-10, 18-13, 18-32, 18-46, 18-58, 18-87, 18-95, 19-16 and 19-47, by amending sections 4 and 6 therein, for the purpose of changing the use and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs for Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 17-84, 18-32, 18-46, 18-58, 18-95 and
3 19-47, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$5,697,383 appropriated by
5 this act, \$219,116 is apportioned to pay the amount
6 owed by the state of Pohnpei to FEMA and \$1,200,000
7 is apportioned for public projects and social
8 programs in the state of Pohnpei.

24 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 17-68, as amended by
 25 Public Laws Nos. 17-71, 18-03, 18-13, 18-58, 18-87 and 19-17, is

1 here by further amended to read as follows:

2 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
3 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
4 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
5 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
6 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
7 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
8 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
9 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
10 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
11 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
12 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
13 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under
14 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
15 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee,
16 EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsection 1 of section 3 of this act shall be the
18 Governor of Kosrae; the allottee of funds appropriated
19 under subsections 3(2)(j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p),
20 (q), (r), (s), (t), (u), (v), (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa),
21 (ab), (ac), (ad), (ae), (af), (ag) and (ah) of section 3
22 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Municipal
23 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
24 appropriated under subsection 1 of section 4 of this act
25 shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State and the allottee

1 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(c)(xxiii) and
2 4(c)(xxiv) of section 4 of this act shall be the
3 Meninkeder lapalap, Madolenihmw Municipal Government.
4 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)
5 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
6 States of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of
7 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(a) and 5(2)(c)
8 and 5(2)(f) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
9 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
10 appropriated under subsection 5(2)(b) of section 5 of
11 this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development
12 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
13 subsection 5(2)(d) of section 5 of this act shall be the
14 Southern Namoneas Development Authority or its designee.
15 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
16 5(2)(e) of section 5 of this act shall be the Faichuk
17 Development Authority or its designee. The allottee of
18 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)(f) of section 5
19 of this act shall be the Northwest Island Development
20 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
21 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
22 30, 2017."

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.

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
