I take the opportunity to express my appreciation to the 19<sup>th</sup> Congress for its expeditious passage of the FY17 budget, which I have signed to become Public Law No. 117 as follows:

Congressional Act No. 19-117: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$70,015,981 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE OPERATIONS OF ALL BRANCHES OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA, ITS AGENCIES, VARIOUS PROGRAMS, GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS AND CAPITAL AND HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

In signing the FY17 budget, I would like to draw the attention of Congress to the following issues that require further consideration:

- 1. On page 1, line 7, an indication is made that the national share from the Amended Compact funds is zero, yet \$9.5 million is in the budget including funding for COM-FSM for its infrastructure improvement. (Page 19 line 24 and page 20, line 9). This conflicting statement must be rectified in order to avoid any possible confusion in implementing the budget.
- 2. Duplication of funding for MRA meetings in the amount of \$20,000 page 17 lines 16 and 24.
- 3. Employment ceilings on page 24, line 23 should be made applicable to 2017 instead of 2016.
- 4. For the Department of Health, \$20,000 funding for Nurse Licensing should be clarified in order to include medical licensing (page 15, line 11)
- 5. Omitted items: arrears for World Intellectual Property (WIPO), Organization for Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), and Comprehensive Nuclear-test-ban treaty organization (CTBT) \$32,129; \$7,962; and \$12,293; respectively.
- 6. Under Section 2 (1) of the Act at page 2, line 3, note that the sum of "\$18,199,317" is an error that does not reflect the actual sum for the operational expenses of the President's Office for FY17.

- 5. Omitted items: arrears for World Intellectual Property (WIPO), Organization for Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), and Comprehensive Nuclear-test-ban treaty organization (CTBT) \$32,129; \$7,962; and €12,293; respectively.
- 6. Under Section 2 (1) of the Act at page 2, line 3, note that the sum of "\$18,199,317" is an errata that does not reflect the actual sum for the operational expenses of the President's Office for FY17.

## PUBLIC LAW No. 19-117

#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$70,015,981 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
