PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-12

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-35, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-49, 18-61, 18-63, 18-78, 18-98, 18-111, 18-123 and 19-06, by amending sections 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of States of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
