A RESOLUTION

Requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to consider establishing a Federated States of Micronesia consulate office on the West Coast of the United States.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Government of the Federated States of
- 2 Micronesia currently does not have any consulate offices in the
- 3 Continental United States; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the largest contingent of the Federated States of
- 5 Micronesia citizens living in the United States mainland reside
- 6 on the West Coast of United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, many citizen living on the West Coast of the
- 8 United States in the states of Oregon, California, and
- 9 Washington are unable to be properly served by the FSM Embassy
- 10 in Washington D.C. due to the time difference and distance; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the complexity of living in the United States as
- 12 a foreign national is becoming increasing difficult to navigate
- 13 without assistance; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the establishment of a consulate office on the
- 15 West Coast of the United States would provide a great service
- 16 to those FSM citizens living in the western states, while
- 17 alleviating the workload on the FSM Embassy in Washington D.C.;
- 18 now, therefore,
- 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Nineteenth Congress of the Federated
- 20 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2016, that
