CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 1-239, CD1, CD2, CD3

## AN ACT

To amend Sections 1, 2 and 4 of Public Law No. 1-90, relating to appropriations from the General Fund during Fiscal Years 1980 and 1981 for the purpose of funding public projects in the state of Kosrae for Fiscal Years 1980 and 1981, and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 1-90 are hereby
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 1. The sum of \$325,000, or so much thereof as may be
4	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
5	Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of funding the
6	following public projects in the State of Kosrae:
7	(1) School buses
8	(2) Road construction and related costs 55,000
9	(3) Sea/River Wall
10	(4) Farm road (Inek)
11	(5) Channel (Inyoa)
12	(6) Recreation facilities (Kufwen Me Srital) 10,000
13	(7) Financial assistance to residents of Kosrae
14	and citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia
15	to attend law school
16	(8) Heavy Equipment
17	(9) Municipal communications 5,000
18	"Section 2. There is hereby created a Kosrae State Commission
19	on Improvement Projects. The Commission shall be composed of
20	one Chief Magistrate from the municipalities of Lelu, Tafunsak,
21	Malem and Utwa, and one appointee each from the Kosrae Delegation
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to the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, the Office

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1	of the State Governor, and from the Speaker of the State
2	Legislature.
3	The Commission should meet to organize itself and to
4	select a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman no later than May 1, 1980
5	A quorum of the Commission is five members; PROVIDED, however,
6	that each Chief Magistrate or his appointee representing each
7	Municipality is present at each meeting. The Commission shall
8	have the authority to:
9	(1) Obligate funds appropriated and allotted to the
10	Commission by the Congress for projects in Kosrae;
11	(2) Award and enter into contracts for projects; giving
12	prior consideration to bids by Kosraen individuals or corpora-
13	tions qualified and capable of performing fully and without
14	delay of such projects;
15	(3) Assess damage to private property caused by projects
16	and negotiate written settlements on amounts of compensation,
17	such written settlements to be treated as obligations for
18	purposes of the Financial Management Act of 1979;
19	(4) Establish priorities for the performance of projects;
20	but ensuring that each municipality is treated as equally as
21	possible;
22	(5) Submit all reports required by applicable law, to
23	include, but not limited to the Financial Management Act of
24	1979;
25	(6) Parliance was the 10k of the finds amountined by

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1	any subsection of a lww appropriating a sum to the Commission;
2	PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the amount apportioned by any
3	subsection shall not be increased by more than 20% by means of
4	reallotment between subsections."
5	Section 2. Section 4 of Public Law No. 1-90 is hereby repealed and
6	a new Section 4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	"Section 4. The funds appropriated by Subsections (1) through
8	(9) of Section 1 are allotted to the Kosrae State Commission on
9	Improvement Projects, and shall be administered and managed in
10	accordance with the provisions of applicable law, including but
11	not limited to the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
12	authority to obligate the funds appropriated by this act shall
13	lapse as of September 30, 1981."
14	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
15	of the Federated States of Micronesia, or upon its becoming law without
16	such approval.
