

A RESOLUTION

Approving and adopting the report of the former Joint Committee on Program and Budget Planning, as transmitted by the Committee on Ways and Means, concerning the Fiscal Year 1981 budget for the Federated States of Micronesia.

1 WHEREAS, the Joint Committee on Program and Budget Planning was
2 established pursuant to Senate Joint Resolution No. IC-2 of the Interim
3 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to determine the fiscal needs
4 of the Federated States of Micronesia and to consult with appropriate
5 officials in all stages of budget development; and

6 WHEREAS, the Joint Committee reviewed and analyzed the High Commis-
7 sioner's target allowances for the Federated States of Micronesia for FY
8 1981; and

9 WHEREAS, the Joint Committee received testimony from appropriate officials
10 in each of the four States and in Saipan on those allowances; and

11 WHEREAS, the Joint Committee has prepared a report containing comments
12 and recommendations relative to the Fiscal Year 1981 budget for the Federated
13 States of Micronesia resulting from careful consideration and deliberation
14 by the Joint Committee; and

15 WHEREAS, Congressional Resolution No. 1-12 authorized and directed the
16 Standing Committee on Ways and Means of the Congress of the Federated States
17 of Micronesia to assume the duties and responsibilities formerly assigned to
18 the Joint Committee on Program and Budget Planning; and

19 WHEREAS, the Committee on Ways and Means supports and has adopted the
20 report of the former Joint Committee, and has therefore transmitted said
21 report to this Congress for adoption; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the First Congress of the Federated States of

1 Micronesia, First Special Session, 1979, that the Congress approves and adopts
2 the report of the former Joint Committee on Program and Budget Planning, as
3 transmitted by the Committee on Ways and Means, concerning the Fiscal Year
4 1981 budget for the Federated States of Micronesia; and
