**CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION NO. 1-66, CD1**

---

**A RESOLUTION**

**Calling for a Second Special Session of the First Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia lasting for ten calendar days in the latter part of January, 1980.**

1       **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2 of Public Law No. IC-30, as amended by**  
2 **Public Law Nos. 1-5 and 1-49, the next regular session of the First Congress**  
3 **of the Federated States of Micronesia will convene on the second Monday of**  
4 **May, 1980; and**

5       **WHEREAS, many important and urgent matters are now before this**  
6 **Congress, including funding of the National Budget for fiscal year 1980,**  
7 **banking regulation, and definition of national crimes and law enforcement**  
8 **and resolutions from the Second State/National Leadership Conference, which**  
9 **will require attention prior to the May Regular Session; and**

10       **WHEREAS, Section 16 of Article IX of the Constitution of the Federated**  
11 **States of Micronesia provides that a special session may be convened at the**  
12 **call of the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, or by the**  
13 **Presiding Officer on the written request of two-thirds of the members; now,**  
14 **therefore,**

15       **BE IT RESOLVED by the First Congress of the Federated States of Micro-**  
16 **nesia, Second Regular Session, 1979, with the concurrence of two-thirds of**  
17 **the members, that a Second Special Session of the First Congress of the**  
18 **Federated States of Micronesia, lasting for not more than ten calendar days,**  
19 **be convened by the Presiding Officer the latter part of January, 1980; and**

20       **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be**  
21 **transmitted to the Speaker of the First Congress of the Federated States of**  
22 **Micronesia, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, the High**

1 Commissioner of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, and the Governor  
2 and Speaker of the state legislature in each of the states of Yap, Truk,  
3 Ponape and Kosrae.
