A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$7,893,977 of supplemental funding from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, by amending sections 1, 2 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42 is hereby

2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Title. The title of this act is as follows: To appropriate the sum of \$[67,903,100] 4 5 75,797,077 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 6 7 2018, for the purpose of funding the operations of all 8 branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, 9 grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and 10 11 Human Resources Development. The National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to 12 13 zero; EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as 14 is reflected in the budget for the Department of 15 Education.
