- 10 the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the
- 11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g)
- 12 and 4(2)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
- 13 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
- 14 subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility
- 15 Corporation (PUC). The allottee of the funds appropriated under
- 16 subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 6(6) of this act shall be the Governor
- 17 of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
- 18 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the
- 19 Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the
- 20 funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the
- 21 Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the funds
- 22 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the
- 23 Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
- 24 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
- 25 30, 2020."

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Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
