## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 12 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), by creating a new chapter 18 to allow for the appointment of a special prosecutor to independently investigate and prosecute claims of alleged national felonies committed by government officials, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States
- 2 of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended, by creating a new
- 3 chapter 18 entitled: "Chapter 18. Special Prosecutor."
- 4 Section 2. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States
- 5 of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new
- 6 section 1801 to chapter 18, to read as follows:
- 7 "Section 1801. Short title. This act shall be
- 8 known and may be cited as the 'Special Prosecutor Act
- 9 of 2011'."
- 10 Section 3. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States
- 11 of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new
- 12 section 1802 to chapter 18, to read as follows:
- 13 "Section 1802. Purpose. The purpose of this act is
- 14 to allow for the appointment of a special prosecutor to
- 15 independently investigate and prosecute claims of
- 16 alleged national felonies committed by senior
- 17 government officials."
- 18 Section 4. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States

of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new 1 2 section 1803 to chapter 18, to read as follows: 3 "Section 1803. Definitions. For the purposes of 4 this chapter, unless the subject or context otherwise requires: 5 6 (1) 'Applicable position in the Government of 7 the Federated States of Micronesia' means the President 8 and Vice President and all positions appointed with the 9 advice and consent of the Congress pursuant to section 10 207(1) of title 2 of this code, including individuals holding such positions in an acting capacity. 11 12 (2) 'Committee' means the Congressional 13 Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations. (3) 'National felony' means any offense 14 15 punishable by more than one year in prison pursuant to this Code. 16 17 (4) 'Judicial panel' means the panel of three Justices established pursuant to section 1804(1) of 18 19 this chapter to appoint and supervise the work of the 20 special prosecutor. 21 (5) 'Justice' means an Associate Justice of the 22 Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia or 23 temporary Justice of the same, appointed pursuant to 24 article XI, section 9 of the Constitution." 25 Section 5. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States

1 of Micronesia (Annotated, is hereby amended by adding a new

- 2 section 1804 to chapter 18, to read as follows:
- 3 "Section 1804. Judicial panel.

- 4 Beginning with the two-year period 5 commencing on the date of the enactment of this 6 chapter, and for each successive two-year period, the 7 Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated 8 States of Micronesia shall appoint three Justices to a 9 judicial panel for the purpose of appointing and 10 supervising special prosecutors. The Chief Justice shall fill any vacancy on the judicial panel for the 11 12 remainder of the two-year period in which the vacancy 13 occurs.
  - (2) The Chief Clerk of the Supreme Court shall serve as the clerk of the judicial panel and shall provide such services as are needed.
- 17 (3) No member of the judicial panel who

  18 participated in a function conferred on the panel under

  19 this chapter involving a special prosecutor shall be

  20 eligible to participate in any judicial proceeding

  21 involving that special prosecutor."
- Section 6. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new section 1805 to chapter 18, to read as follows:
- 25 "Section 1805. Request for the appointment of a

1	special prosecutor.
2	(1) The Congressional Committee on Judiciary
3	and Governmental Operations may request in writing that
4	the judicial panel appoint a special prosecutor. Such a
5	request should be based on:
6	(a) information and belief that an
7	individual may have committed a national felony while
8	holding an applicable position in the Government of the
9	Federated States of Micronesia; and
10	(b) a finding of a conflict of interest or
11	other specific reason that the investigation or
12	prosecution of this matter could not be effectively
13	conducted by the Attorney General or the Department of
14	Justice.
15	(2) The Committee's request shall contain
16	sufficient information to constitute grounds for
17	investigation, but need not specify a particular
18	individual or violation."
19	Section 7. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States
20	of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new
21	section 1806 to chapter 18, to read as follows:
22	"Section 1806. Appointment and jurisdiction of
23	special prosecutor.
24	(1) Within ninety (90) days of receipt of a
25	written request pursuant to section 1805 of this

1 chapter, the judicial panel shall appoint as special 2 prosecutor an individual who has appropriate 3 experience, has no conflicts of interest, and who will 4 conduct the investigation and any prosecution in a prompt, responsible, and cost-effective manner. 5 6 (2) The judicial panel shall define the 7 jurisdiction of the special prosecutor, ensuring that 8 he has adequate authority to fully investigate and 9 prosecute the subject matter with respect to which the Committee has requested his appointment, and all 10 matters related to that subject matter. Such 11 12 jurisdiction shall also include the authority to 13 investigate and prosecute national felonies that may 14 arise out of the investigation or prosecution of that 15 subject matter, including perjury, hindering 16 prosecution, tampering with or fabricating evidence, 17 and tampering with witnesses or informants. (3) The judicial panel may expand the 18 19 jurisdiction of the special prosecutor if the special 20 prosecutor discovers or receives information about 21 additional possible violations of criminal law, and the 22 judicial panel, giving great weight to any 23 recommendations of the special prosecutor, determines 24 that there are reasonable grounds for such expansion." 25 Section 8. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States

of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new 1 2 section 1807 to chapter 18, to read as follows: 3 "Section 1807. Authority of special prosecutor. 4 special prosecutor shall have full power and independent authority to exercise all investigative 5 6 and prosecutorial functions and powers of the 7 Department of Justice and the Attorney General." 8 Section 9. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States 9 of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new 10 section 1808 to chapter 18, to read as follows: "Section 1808. Funding. Upon appointment of a 11 12 special prosecutor pursuant to section 1806 of this 13 chapter, Congress shall appropriate funds for the 14 operations and expenses of the special prosecutor 15 relating to the specific matter under investigation. The judicial panel shall authorize the disbursement of 16 17 such funds as it deems necessary to the performance of the special prosecutor's duties." 18 19 Section 10. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States 20 of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new 21 section 1809 to chapter 18, to read as follows: 22 "Section 1809. Reports and oversight. 23 The Congressional Committee on Judiciary (1)24 and Governmental Operations shall have oversight 25 jurisdiction with respect to the official conduct of

any special prosecutor appointed under this chapter,
and a special prosecutor shall have the duty to
cooperate with the exercise of such oversight
jurisdiction.

- (2) Every six months, a special prosecutor shall file with the judicial panel a report which identifies and explains expenses incurred during the six month period, and estimates future expenses.
- (3) A special prosecutor shall annually, and upon termination of his appointment, submit to the Congress a report on his activities, including a description of the progress of any investigation or prosecution. Such report may omit any matter that in the judgment of the special prosecutor should be kept confidential, but shall provide information adequate to justify the expenditures that the office of the special prosecutor has made.
- (4) A special prosecutor shall advise the

  Congress of any substantial and credible information he

  receives that may constitute grounds for an

  impeachment.
- (5) Upon completion of an investigation or termination of a special prosecutor all documents shall be turned over to the judicial panel and retained until the relevant statute of limitations for any alleged

2	Section 11. Title 12 of the Code of the Federated States
3	of Micronesia (Annotated), is hereby amended by adding a new
4	section 1810 to chapter 18, to read as follows:
5	"Section 1810. Termination.
6	(1) A special prosecutor's appointment shall
7	terminate:
8	(a) when either the special prosecutor or
9	the judicial panel determines that the investigation of
10	all matters within the special prosecutor's
11	jurisdiction and any resulting prosecutions have been
12	<pre>completed;</pre>
13	(b) on the special prosecutor's
14	resignation or death; or
15	(c) when the special prosecutor is removed
16	by the judicial panel for good cause, physical or
17	mental disability, or any other condition that
18	substantially impairs the performance of the special
19	prosecutor's duties.
20	(2) If a special prosecutor is removed from
21	office, the judicial panel shall promptly submit to the
22	Committee a report specifying the facts found and the
23	ultimate grounds for such removal. A special prosecutor
24	who has been removed from office may obtain judicial
25	review of the removal in a civil action in the Supreme

Court of the Federated States of Micronesia. A member 1 of the judicial panel may not hear or determine any 2 3 such civil action or any appeal of a decision in any such civil action. The special prosecutor may be 4 reinstated or granted other appropriate relief by order 5 6 of the court. 7 (3) If a vacancy arises by reason of the 8 resignation, death, or removal of a special prosecutor, the judicial panel shall appoint a new special 9 10 prosecutor to fill the vacancy." 11 Section 12.
