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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1 and 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160 and 20-23 in order to appropriate \$1,988,484 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

12	and Capital and Human Resources Development. The
13	National Government's share of the Amended Compact
14	funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT, the
15	National Government will retain 10 percent of the
16	Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in
17	the budget for the Department of Education. The sum

appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"

Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended 1 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 2 20-14 and 20-23, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. 4 5 The sum of  $\{40,606,363\}$  42,594,847, which includes \$556,074 in SEG funding that was previously omitted, 6 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated 8 9 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 10 September 30, 2017, for the following capital improvements, development programs, and projects and 11 human resources development. Of the total amount of 12 funds appropriated herein, \$1,802,096 shall be deemed 13 to come from funds available under the Amended Compact 14 15 from the Supplemental Education Grant and \$9,545,500 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 16 17 Amended Compact from Compact Sector Grants.
