A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 and 9 of Public Law No 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-57 and 20-67 by appropriating of \$71,250 of additional Supplemental Education Grant for the National Department of Education, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
- 2 Public Law No. 20-54 and 20-67, is hereby further amended to read

- 12 Resources Development. The National Government's share
- of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero;
- 14 EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain 10
- 15 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is
- 16 reflected in the budget for the Department of Education.
- 17 The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as
- 18 follows:"
- 19 Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by

1 Public Laws Nos. 20-64 and 20-67, is hereby amended to read as 2 follows: 3 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. 4 The sum of $\{38,400,179\}$ 38,471,429, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the 5 6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for 7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the following capital improvements, development programs, 8 9 and projects and human resources development. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$[1,246,022] 10 11 1,317,272 shall be deemed to come from funds available 12 under the Amended Compact from the Supplemental Education Grant and \$5,252,250 shall be deemed to come 13 14 from funds available under the Amended Compact from 15 Compact Sector Grants.
