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PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-79

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-32, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-45, 19-61, 19-83, 19-95 and 19-122, by amending sections 1 and 9 thereof, to deappropriate an amount of \$800,000 from the Capital and Human Resources Development for the state of Kosrae infrastructure priority projects funding, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

The title of this act is as follows: To appropriate the sum of \$74,629,823 from the 5 6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for 7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the 8 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the 9 National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, 10 11 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. The National Government's share 12 of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero 13 except that the National Government will retain 10 14 15 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for the Department of Education. 16 The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as 17
