AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83 and 20-94, in order to appropriate \$655,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by

The National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT 13 14 THAT; the National Government will retain 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected 15 in the budget for the Department of Education. 16 17 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:" 18 Section 2.
