AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-155, by amending sections 2, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

24	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
25	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that

no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 2(c) of this act shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee. allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the Isokohnedi of Kitti Municipal Council; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a) and 4(2)(b) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d) 4(2)(e) and 4(3)(f) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e) and 4(3)(f) of this act shall be the Luhken Moanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Secretary of
