- 2 September 11, 1924, and passed away on April 6, 2018, in

- 4 WHEREAS, Daniel Kahikina Akaka was an American educator and
- 5 politician who was a United States Democratic Senator from
- 6 Hawaii from 1990 to 2013, the first U.S. Senator of Native
- 7 Hawaiian ancestry; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Daniel Kahikina Akaka served in the U.S. Army
- 9 Corps of Engineers during World War II; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Daniel Kahikina Akaka attended the University of
- 11 Hawaii, where he received his bachelor's and master's degrees;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, Daniel Kahikina Akaka originally was a high school
- 14 teacher, he went on to serve as a principal for six years and in
- 15 1969, the Department of Education hired him as a chief program
- 16 planner; and
- 17 WHEREAS in the 1970s, Daniel Kahikina Akaka served in
- 18 various governmental positions until he was elected to the
- 19 United States House of Representatives in 1976 to represent
- 20 Hawaii's 2nd congressional district, comprising all of the
- 21 states outside the inner ring of Honolulu, a position to which

he was re-elected seven times; and
WHEREAS, Daniel Kahikina Akaka is survived by his wife Mary
Mildred Chong, whom he married in 1948; a dauther, Millannie,
four sons, Daniel Jr., Gerald, Alan, and Nicholas; and many
grandchildren and great-grandchildren, now, therefore,
