Your Committee on Ways & Means, to which was referred Congressional Bill No. 20-272, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND TITLE 55 OF THE CODE OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA (ANNOTATED), AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 205, 224, AND 224B, AND FURTHER AMENDING SECTION 219, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-154, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLARIFYING PROVISIONS OF THE FINANCIAL MANANGEMENT ACT OF 1979 RELATING TO THE ACCOUTING DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY OF FINANCE, THE DOCUMENTATY EVIDENCE REQUIRED TO SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS, DISBURSEMENT PROCEDURES, AND THE DEFINITION OF "REPRESENTATION EXPENSE", AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.",

the bill amends the accounting duties of the Secretary of Finance to clarify that the Secretary may withhold approval for a disbursement if the disbursement would violate an appropriation. The bill further provides that if the Secretary fails to disburse funds within 30 days of the funds becoming payable, the Secretary must provide documentary evidence to the allottee that the disbursement would violate a specific appropriation. Your Committee notes that, under current law and as proposed in the bill, the Secretary is not authorized to question the validity of the appropriation itself. Finally, the bill clarifies the definition of "representation expense", and provides that when an affidavit is provided as documentary evidence for representation expenses, the affidavit include the amount, recipient, and use of the expenditure.

Your Committee on Ways and Means is in accord with the intent and purpose of C.B. No. 20-272, and recommends passage of the bill on First Reading and that it be placed on the Calendar for Second and Final Reading in the form attached hereto as C.B. 20-272.
