1 WHEREAS, the United Nations Population Fund extended to 2 the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia a grant in 3 the amount of \$125,000, as evidenced by the attached FSM's 2018 Work Plan signed on April 12, 2018; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to fund and support the implementation of the allocated Programmes in the 2018 Work 6 Plan for the FSM focusing directly on:1) Integrated Sexual and 7 8 Reproductive Health; 2) Gender Equality and Women's 9 Empowerment, including addressing Gender Based Violence; and 3) 10 Data Availability and Analysis; and WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the 11 12 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, requires that for an agreement on foreign financial assistance 13 to be valid it must be approved by Congress by resolution; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the FSM Government expresses appreciation to the 16 United Nations Population Fund for the funding assistance made 17 available to the Federated States of Micronesia; now, 18 therefore,
