AN ACT

To amend section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94 and 20-103 and 20-122 to, change the use of certain CIP line items in the FY18 Budget Act in order to provide for AIP matching funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94, 20-103  
3 and 20-122 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

5           The sum of \$119,685,179, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
8 year ending September 30, 2018, for the following  
9 capital improvements, development programs, and projects  
10 and human resources development. Of the total amount of  
11 funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022 shall be deemed to  
12 come from funds available under the Amended Compact from  
13 the Supplemental Education Grant and \$5,252,250 shall be  
14 deemed to come from funds available under the Amended  
15 Compact from Compact Sector Grants. The sum  
16 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
17 follows:
