**PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-01**

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AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135 and 19-146, in order to appropriate \$1,684,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, to change the allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135 and 19-146, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is as  
5 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$74,328,445 from  
6 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia  
7 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the  
8 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of  
9 the National Government of the Federated States of  
10 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,  
11 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human  
12 Resources Development. The National Government's  
13 share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to  
14 zero; EXCEPT THAT, the National Government will retain  
15 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds  
16 as is reflected in the budget for the Department of  
17 Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be

1           apportioned as follows:"

2           Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended  
3 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-135 and 19-146, is hereby further  
4 amended to read as follows:

5           "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch.  
6           The sum of \$18,463,317 or so much thereof as may be  
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
8 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal

15 Section 6. Section 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended  
16 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125 and 19-135, is hereby further amended  
17 to read as follows:

18 "Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds  
19 and Lapse Dates.

20 (1) General provisions.

21 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
22 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
23 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
24 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

25 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for



1           ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may  
2           be necessary, are used solely for the purposes  
3           specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
4           incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

5           (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds  
6           appropriated by this act are as follows:

7                   (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds  
8           shall be the President of the Federated States of  
9           Micronesia;

10                   (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds  
11           shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated  
12           States of Micronesia;

13                   (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds  
14           shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the  
15           Federated States of Micronesia;

16                   (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds  
17           shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of  
18           Micronesia;

19                   (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee  
20           of these funds shall be the President of the  
21           Federated States of Micronesia; PROVIDED,  
22           HOWEVER, that for the following subsections of  
23           sections 8 through 9 of this act:

24                           (i) Section 8(1)(g)(ii) - the  
25           allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of

1 the Joint Committee on Compact Review and  
2 Planning (JCRP);

3 (ii) Section 8(6)(g) – the allottee  
4 shall be the President of the College of  
5 Micronesia – FSM;

6 (iii) Section 8(6)(h) through (i) and  
7 Section 8(8)(c) – allottee of these funds shall  
8 be the Governor of Chuuk State.

9 (iv) Section 8(9)(a) through (x) –  
10 the allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker  
11 of the Congress of the Federated States of  
12 Micronesia;

13 (v) Section 8(12)(a) through (d) –  
14 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief  
15 Justice of the respective State Supreme Court;

16 (vi) Section 8(12)(o) – the allottee  
17 of these funds shall be the Governor of the  
18 respective States;

19 (vii) Section 8(12)(p) – the allottee  
20 of these funds shall be the Governor of the  
21 State of Yap;

22 (viii) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) –  
23 the allottee of these funds shall be the  
24 President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

25 (ix) Section 9(3)(i)(i) – the

1 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of  
2 the State of Yap;

3 (x) Section 9(4)(b) through (e) –  
4 the allottee of these funds shall be the  
5 Governor of the respective States;

6 (xi) Section 9(12)(b) – the allottee  
7 of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the  
8 Chuuk State Supreme Court.

9 (xii) Section 9(12)(d) – the allottee  
10 of these funds shall be the Speaker of the  
11 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.

12 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the  
13 allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this  
14 act shall lapse as of September 30, 2017,  
15 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated  
16 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.”

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1           Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
