PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-159

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 6, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 20-131, as amended by Public Law No. 20-154, in order to appropriate \$1,703,641 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, to provide additional funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-131, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 20-154, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 “Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
5 appropriate the sum of \$67,960,911 from the General Fund
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
7 year ending September 30, 2019, for the purpose of
8 funding the operations of all branches of the National
9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its
10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
11 contributions and Capital and Human Resources
12 Development. The National Government’s share of the
13 Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT
14 THAT; the National Government will retain the Compact
15 Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent of the
16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in
17 the budget for the Department of Education. The sum

1 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"

2 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 20-131, as amended by
3 Public Law No. 20-154, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch.

6 The sum of \$22,810,156, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
8 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal

22 Section 6. Section 12 of Public Law No. 20-131
23 is hereby amended to read as follows:

24 “Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and
25 Lapse Dates.”

1 (1) General provisions.

2 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
3 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
4 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
5 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

6 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
7 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
9 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
10 of the sums appropriated.

11 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
12 appropriated by this act are as follows:

13 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
14 shall be the President of the Federated States of
15 Micronesia;

16 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds
17 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia;

19 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds
20 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
21 Federated States of Micronesia;

22 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds
23 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
24 Micronesia;

1 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
2 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
3 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
4 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

5 (i) Sections 8(1)(f) and 8(8)(h) - the
6 allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint
7 Committee on Compact Review and Planning;

8 (ii) Section 8(8)(c) - the allottee of these
9 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

10 (iii) Section 8(9) - the allottee of these
11 funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
12 Federated States of Micronesia;

13 (iv) Section 8(12)(a) - the allottee of
14 these funds shall be the President of the College of
15 Micronesia-FSM;

16 (v) Section 8(12)(e) through (h) - the
17 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
18 the respective State Supreme Court;

19 (vi) Section 8(12)(q) - the allottee of
20 these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on
21 Compact Review and Planning;

22 (vii) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these
23 funds shall be the President of the College of
24 Micronesia-FSM;

1 (viii) Section 9(3)(g) – the allottee of these
2 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

3 (ix) Section 9(3)(h) – the allottee of these
4 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

5 (x) Section 9(3)(i) – the allottee of these
6 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

7 (xi) Section 9(3)(j) – the allottee of these
8 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

9 (xii) Section 9(14) – the allottee of these
10 funds shall be Telecommunication Regulation Authority;

11 (xiii) Section 9(15)(a)(1) – the allottee of
12 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of
13 Kosrae;

14 (xiv) Section 9(15)(a)(2) – the allottee of
15 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of
16 Pohnpei;

17 (xv) Section 9(15)(a)(3) – the allottee of
18 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

19 (xvi) Section 9(15)(a)(4) – the allottee of
20 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

21 (xvii) Section 9(15)(d) – the allottee of
22 these funds shall be the Governor of the state of
23 Pohnpei;

1 (xviii) Section 9(15)(e)(1) and (3) – the
2 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the
3 state of Chuuk;

4 (xix) Section 9(15)(e)(2) – the allottee of
5 these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia.

7 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
8 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
9 of September 30, 2019; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
10 appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not
11 lapse.”

12 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
14 becoming law without such approval.
