A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 19-145, 19-158, 20-09, 20-22, 20-51, 20-59, 20-70, 20-123, 20-162, 20-170 and 21-35, by amending sections 3 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-121, as amended 3 4 by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 20-09, 20-70, 20-123, 20-162, 5 20-170 and 21-35, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 6 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and 7 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 8 9 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The 10 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 11 12 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that 13 14 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated 15 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of 16 17 Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under section 2(k) shall be the President 18 of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of 19 20 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act 21 shall be the President of the Federated States of 22 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) through 23 3(z) shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal 24 25 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under

subsections 3(aa) - 3(all) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government, or his designee EXCEPT THAT the allottee of fund appropriated under subsection 3(au) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(a) of this act shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(1), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2(g), 4(2)(h), 4,(2)(i), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(1) and 4(2)(m) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) shall be the Office of Fisheries, Pohnpei State; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(n) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(b) shall be the Pohnpei State Public Safety; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(c) and 4(3(e) of this act shall be the

3	shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of
4	funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and

7	under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
8	Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
9	appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
10	the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
11	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
12	this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
13	The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
14	appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
15	2020."
16	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
17	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
18	becoming law without such approval.
