## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 19-145, 19-158, 20-09, 20-22, 20-51, 20-59, 20-70, 20-123, 20-162, 20-170, 21-35, 21-66, 21-112 and 21-127, by amending sections 3 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-121, as amended 4 by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 20-09, 20-70, 20-123, 20-162, 5 6 20-170, 21-35, 21-66 and 21-127, is hereby further amended to 7 read as follows: "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and 8 9 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 10 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not 11 12 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The 13 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 14 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that 15 16 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 17 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of 18 Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds 19 20 appropriated under section 2(k) shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of 21 22 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of 23 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee 24 of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) through 25

1 3(z) shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his 2 designee[Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government]; the 3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(aa) - 3(all) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government, or 4 his designee EXCEPT THAT the allottee of fund 5 6 appropriated under subsection 3(au) of this act shall 7 be the Governor of Kosrae or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(a) of this 8 9 act shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State or his 10 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(1), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(i) of 11 12 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority 13 (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under 14 subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2(g), 4(2)(h), 4,(2)(i), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(1) and 15 16 4(2)(m) shall be the Secretary of the Department of 17 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under 18 subsection 4(2)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Utility 19 20 Corporation (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated 21 under subsection 4(2)(c) shall be the Office of Fisheries, Pohnpei State; the allottee of funds 22 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(n) shall be the 23 Secretary of the Department of Education or his 24 25 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under

1 subsection 4(3)(b) shall be the Pohnpei State Public 2 Safety; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(c) and 4(3(e)) of this act shall be the 3 Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; allottee of funds 4 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(m) 5 6 shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of 7 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his 8 9 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under 10 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds 11 12 appropriated under section 5(3) of this act shall be 13 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee. 14 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas 15 16 Development Authority. The allottee of funds 17 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of 18 the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act 19 20 shall lapse on September 30, 2022." 21 22 23 24
